

Borough of Totowa Community Pool Rules of Conduct 2017

Pool Open June 17th to Sept. 4th

The following rules have been imposed to assure safe and sanitary conditions. It is the responsibility of the members to follow these rules and make sure their guests follow them as well. All rules were carefully designed to protect the swimmers as well as the lifeguards.

Weather permitting hours:

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday	12:00 noon to 7:00pm
Friday	12:00 noon to 8:00pm
Saturday, Sunday and Holidays	11:00am to 8:00pm

1. The Pool Staff reserves the right to close the pool whenever the safety or health of the members is endangered or during inclement weather.
2. The Pool Staff reserves the right to deny persons access to the pool upon evidence of illness, skin disease, open wounds or sores or discharge of bodily fluid.
3. No infant will be allowed in the pool unless wearing leak proof rubber pants over diaper.
4. Animals are not permitted on pool property, including parking and picnic grove areas.
5. Food, drink and suntan lotions are not permitted on the deck areas and inside pool. NO GLASS containers of any kind are allowed on pool grounds.
6. NO ALCOHOL is permitted on pool property, including parking and picnic grove areas.
7. The pool is not liable for loss of valuables.
8. Conduct in the swimming pool and on the grounds:
 - a. Horseplay will not be tolerated.
 - b. Rafts, toys, inner-tubes and beach balls only shall be permitted in the first, second and third sections of the pool at the discretion of the Pool Staff.
 - c. Swimmies are not permitted past the second section.
 - d. Ball playing at the discretion of Pool Manager.
 - e. Footbaths must be used before entering pool.
9. Diving is permitted from red zones only! Diving is prohibited from the other areas of the deck.
10. There shall be no retrieving of objects from bottom of the deep end unless instructed by the lifeguard on duty.
11. The lifeguards reserve the right to test swimmers before entering the deep end. If one fails the swimming test, the lifeguard has the right to deny access to any waters above shoulders.
12. Congregating around the lifeguard stands will not be permitted. For the safety and protection of all, social conversations with lifeguards on duty are not permitted.
13. **All members will be issued a badge that must be worn visibly on the outside of the swimsuit. No member shall be permitted inside the pool area without this badge.**
14. A lost badge must be reported immediately. A replacement badge will be issued for a \$10.00 fee.
15. Membership badges are **NON TRANSFERRABLE**. Anyone transferring a badge will have their badge suspended or revoked upon the decision of the Board of Recreation or Pool Manger.
16. Guests are to be accompanied by an adult Pool Member, 18 years of age or older. However, a minor member of the Pool may have an adult non-member as their guest providing that said adult is a family member (i.e. grandparent, aunt, or uncle) and has written permission from the parents, and pay the appropriate guest fee. The letter must include the name of the non-member and the date(s) the minor will be in his/her care.
17. Members are responsible to pay guest fees for guests entering the pool grounds. A guest wristband and receipt will be issued in the member's name. Wristbands are only valid for the date stamped and must be worn by guest. Any tampering with wristbands will result in the loss of membership privileges.
18. No rain-checks will be issued to pool guests after 3pm.
19. Children must be supervised at all times including restrooms, vending area, pool area and picnic/park area.
20. Children under 18 are not to be left at Pool unattended and must be in the care of an adult member. Members who leave children unattended risk the loss of membership privileges.
21. Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the pool area.

Failure to comply with these rules will result in the loss of privileges.
