

Hi, this is Mayor John Coiro.

As of last week, we now have 318 Totowa residents who have been confirmed testing positive for the corona virus. This is 11 more than I reported to you in my last message at the end of June. We will need to keep up the good work with the preventive measures you are all taking as the restrictions in NJ continue to ease. In Passaic County, the total confirmed positive has passed 20,000.

Passaic County has expanded its offering of saliva tests to Totowa residents in order to test for the corona virus. These saliva tests can be ordered through the Passaic County website and are free of charge. Additionally, you can drive to any mobile test site to be administered the saliva test. It is free and no prescription is necessary. Just bring your ID with you. And do not eat, drink, smoke or chew gum for at least 30 minutes prior to testing. Check the Totowa website for the dates and locations.

Due to the potential of a thunderstorm this evening, the concert featuring the Infernos has been postponed. The concert has been rescheduled for this Saturday, July 25th at 7 pm at the Totowa PAL field off of Chamberlain Ave. As some of you already know, we opened our playgrounds around town earlier this month. While the equipment has been and continues to be sanitized, please have your children practice preventive measures where possible
