

Hi, this is Mayor John Coiro.

Since my last message to you approximately two weeks ago, we have seen an increase of 127 confirmed cases of Totowa residents who have tested positive for the corona virus, with 79 last week. This brings our total confirmed positive cases since March to 675. So please be vigilant with the preventive measures you are all taking as we are seeing cases spike throughout the country and State of NJ.

The Totowa and Woodland Park Fire Departments will be parading through the streets of Totowa with numerous fire trucks on the evenings of Monday, December 14 and Tuesday, December 15 from 5 PM until 9 PM. They will be following the zones we use for the pick up of recycling. So on the 14th, the parade will be on the streets throughout Zone 1, which is for those who normally have their recycling picked up on Wednesdays. On the 15th, the parade will be on the streets throughout Zone 2, which is for those who normally have their recycling picked up on Thursdays. If you do not know which zone you are in, you can check our website or the Fire Department website. Please watch from your porches and do not approach the trucks.

The Fire Department will also be hosting a toy drive for children in local hospitals. You can drop off an unwrapped toy at the firehouse on 11 Mitchell Avenue on Sunday December 13th from 10 AM until noon or on Monday December 14 from 5-9 pm.
