**CURBSIDE PICK-UP:**

**Commingled Recyclables:** shall include plastic bottles (types 1 - 7), bi-metal steel cans, glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, juice and milk containers/cartons, all Styrofoam, all plastics, pots & pans. These items can all be placed into the same container.

**Mixed Paper/Newspaper:** shall consist of corrugated cardboard, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, telephone books, paperback books, chipboard, office paper, school paper and brown paper bags. These items can all be placed together.

**FOR ALL HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES:** Refrigerators, air conditioners, washers, dryers, hot water heaters, etc., you shall go to the Borough Clerk's Office to arrange for a pick up and pay the following fees in advance.

Refrigerators, air conditioners and any other items containing Freon	\$ 10.00
All other appliances	\$ 5.00

**OTHER RECYCLING FEES—PAID IN ADVANCE AT BOROUGH CLERK'S OFFICE:**

All Electronics For Pick Up	\$5.00
All Tires	\$5.00

**ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE RECYCLING DROP-OFF CENTER:**

**-GRASS & BRUSH** (A PICKUP SCHEDULE WILL BE SENT IN THE SPRING OF 2013).

**-HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE** (PASSAIC COUNTY WILL ANNOUNCE THEIR COLLECTION DAYS/LOCATIONS FOR 2013 AT A LATER DATE).

**-CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION DEBRIS** (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO: WOOD, DOORS, ASPHALT SHINGLES, CONCRETE, ETC.) THESE ITEMS MUST BE RECYCLED BY THE CONTRACTOR WHO DOES THE WORK. IF HOMEOWNER DOES THE WORK CALL NUMBERS LISTED ABOVE FOR INFORMATION.

# CONTINUED FOR 2013

**STYROFOAM**—cups, egg cartons and packing materials; **PLASTIC BAGS, BUBBLE WRAP, SHRINK WRAP, ANY TYPE OF PLASTIC**—yogurt, cake, cookie and take-out containers, **RIGID PLASTICS**—molded lawn furniture, buckets and toys; **POTS & PANS**; Can now all be placed in with your Commingled Recyclables.

**JUICE & MILK CONTAINERS/CARTONS**: Please place your juice and milk containers/cartons in with your Commingled Recyclables.

**COMPUTERS & ELECTRONICS RECYCLING**: There will be a container at the Recycling Center to deposit all old electronics, such as: computers, monitors, televisions, CD & DVD players, stereo equipment, copiers, printers, faxes, radios, telephones, typewriters, etc., or basically anything with a plug. **Electronics WILL NOT be picked up with your regular household garbage and must be brought to the Recycling Center.**

**Recycling Drop-Off Center**: There will be night hours on Wednesdays from 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and weekend hours on Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.

**At Curbside**: All Commingled Recyclables together in one container; All paper items together in a separate container will continue to be picked up at the curb on your regular recycling day.

**Commingle Your Recyclables**: Place all of your plastic bottles (types 1 - 7), glass bottles and jars, bi-metal steel cans, aluminum cans, juice and milk containers/cartons, all Styrofoam items listed above, all plastic items listed above and pots & pans into the same container.

**Corrugated Cardboard**: Must be recycled at the curb on your regular recycling day or brought to the Recycling Center and placed into the cardboard compactor. **Cardboard WILL NOT be picked up with your regular household garbage.**

**At The Recycling Center**: If you bring your recyclables to the Recycling Center, it is requested that you continue to separate your aluminum cans and deposit them in their own separate container. All other items mentioned above can still be commingled and placed in the commingled container. Cardboard shall still be separated and placed in the cardboard compactor. All other mixed newspaper shall be placed in the mixed newspaper container.

**ALL ITEMS LISTED ABOVE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED WITH YOUR REGULAR HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE AND MUST BE RECYCLED.**
